Dues are non-refundable. Businesses, not individuals, are Chamber members. A member's principal representative carries that member's voting power and may be elected to serve as an officer or a member of the Executive Committee or Board of Directors. A member's associate representatives, although not having that member's voting or office holding privileges, may serve and vote at the Committee level. Chamber publications will commonly list principal and associate representatives. Becoming a member authorizes the Chamber to send e-mail, mail, telephone and fax notifications of upcoming events and news.
